The doctors of Montville Oral Surgery Associates stay on the leading edge of the art and the evidence-based science of dental implants. "We have the newest generation of cone-beam CT (computer

tomography), allowing us to create a three-dimensional image of our patient's mouth and face," explains Dr. Pirozzi. "We can perform a virtual surgery prior to performing our patient's actual procedure, thus increasing accuracy and reducing the time needed to place the implants."

Platelet-rich plasma (PRP) therapy, using the body's own stem cells—harvested in the office—and other bioengineered growth factors are available to promote healing of tissues when appropriate.

"We strive to optimize every step when preparing for and placing implants," says Dr. Ernst. "We believe we have one chance to get it right, and we honor that challenge."

FOCUS ON COMFORT

Whether removing wisdom teeth, placing dental implants, or providing any one of the other in-office procedures, the surgeons and staff of Montville Oral Surgery Associates place patient safety and comfort at the forefront.
