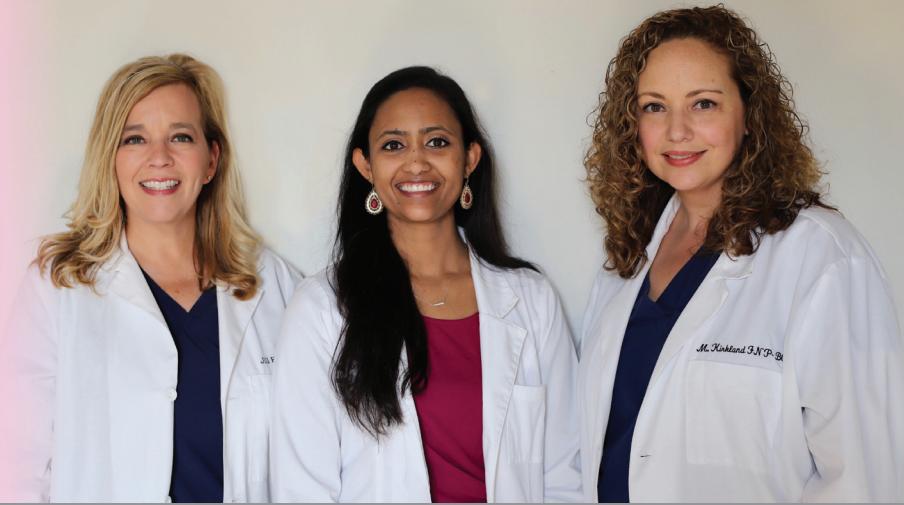


# ALEXANDER PEDIATRICS: OFFERING PERSONALIZED CARE FOR MORE THAN 30 YEARS

Dr. Alexander started out by herself, but she has since expanded the practice so much that, in 2019, she built a new, larger building to better accommodate her patients. She currently has two experienced Nurse Practitioners working alongside her. “My NPs are highly capable of providing care for our patients,” she says.

Michelle Kirkland, Family Nurse Practitioner, joined the practice in 2013. Kirkland has served the River Region area for more than 15 years.

Jill Fitch, Family Nurse Practitioner, joined the practice in 2018. She has been working with children and adolescents in the River Region for almost 20 years and is “honored to continue to do so as a part of the Alexander Pediatrics team.”

“We see children for various reasons, including their routine visits, sick visits, and immunizations,” Dr. Alexander continues. “We take same-day appointments and walk-ins.”

Alexander Pediatrics is a general pediatric outpatient practice. The

providers manage routine healthcare—not only well-child care, but also asthma, allergies, eczema, obesity, and hypertension. They also case manage with other specialists and their specific recommendations.

Each patient receives individualized attention at Alexander Pediatrics. The staff strives to make wait times as short as possible.

“Anyone can get sick at any time. As a parent, I don’t want to be waiting for hours for an appointment. So, I don’t want my patients waiting,” Dr. Alexander says. “However, no one should be rushed out either. The parent and patient should feel that all their issues have been addressed.”
