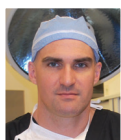




Small-Town Plastic Surgery Practice Proud of Quality Results, Exceptional Pricing

“There is no such thing as a ‘cosmetic surgery specialist,’ and you should be dubious about the credentials of someone who claims this,” says Bolling. “He or she probably isn’t board certified in plastic surgery.

“There’s no professional oversight for ‘cosmetic surgery specialists,’ and it’s not a specialty recognized by the American Board of Medical Specialties,” Bolling continues. “There’s a huge difference between a cosmetic surgeon and a plastic surgeon; specifically, a board-certified plastic surgeon goes through extensive and superior training. So before you choose a doctor, be sure you do your research and make sure he or she is board certified in plastic surgery.”
