**W**hat began as a small, two exam-room office in Hollywood, Florida, has transformed into the largest privately owned primary care pediatric practice in the state. Pediatric Associates was one of the first medical groups to introduce satellite office locations staffed by multiple physicians and one of the first pediatric groups to embrace managed care in the 1970s. Currently, Pediatric Associates has 31 offices in South Florida, two in Tampa, and two in Jacksonville.

The practice's decision to expand north to Tampa and Jacksonville was made to meet the needs of a growing patient population. Pediatric Associates began its expansion north in 2013 and acquired three practices in the Tampa Bay area. The organization made its way to Jacksonville in 2015 with the acquisition of a large, multi-office practice. “As we grew, we never lost sight of our mission to enhance the lives of all children, their families, and their communities by delivering the highest quality of pediatric healthcare and service possible

in a compassionate and healthy environment,” says CEO Dr. Peter Shulman.

### New Locations in Town Center and Main Street

Within only a few years, Jacksonville Pediatric Associates had already outgrown its downtown location, and so, in the summer of 2018, the office was relocated to a brand-new space in the historic district and rechristened as the Main Street office. It has a colorful and vibrant “around the world” theme. The new Southside location opened its doors as Jacksonville Pediatric Associates Town Center and features an “under the sea” theme. The two locations better serve the community with upgraded amenities, additional exam rooms, and expanded X-ray and laboratory services.
