He seeks to diminish the fear patients carry with them and instead instill them with confidence. "We care about our patients, and I want them to know that," Dr. Bobst shares.

Wisdom Teeth Extraction

Wisdom teeth removal is a procedure no one looks forward to but that nearly everyone will need to have done. Dr. Bobst says that with his experience, this surgery is routine. "We can consult with the patient and perform the surgery all in the same day, and we ensure patients are properly sedated and comfortable throughout," he adds.

While patients of all ages are subject to extraction, Dr. Bobst recommends that the procedure be completed as early as possible. When performed at younger ages, patients typically heal faster and experience fewer infections and nerve complications. "Younger patients require less recovery time and may benefit from improved periodontal health and less crowding," he says.

Whether for a social call or to discuss a complex surgical issue, Dr. Bobst invites everyone to stop by the office and say hi. "I would appreciate the opportunity to meet with you," he concludes. "Your care is our No. 1 concern."

Dental Implants

Dental implants account for a significant portion of Dr. Bobst's schedule. Experienced in all implant technologies, he's particularly adept at fullmouth replacement.

"Implants are ideal for patients looking for a longterm, healthy, and costeffective solution for replacing missing or failing teeth," Dr. Bobst explains. "Dental implants are comfortable and reliable, and they prevent the destructive bone atrophy that can occur when there is no longer a tooth root secured within the jaw bone."

Implant options include traditional titanium, zygomatic (longer implants based closer to the cheekbone and used when there is not enough bone present for traditional implants), and zirconia implants for patients seeking a more holistic, biocompatible option.

According to Dr. Bobst, anyone who desires more confidence and a better smile can get implants. "But patients must seek out a provider who has extensive experience and quality training," he notes. "With us, you'll find both."
