When Dr. Iranmanesh examines a patient, he is not only focused on their teeth—his holistic approach to dental care considers their needs and concerns to create long-lasting smiles. “I look at aesthetics and function when improving someone’s smile,” he explains. “Aesthetics without functionality will not last long.” His method aims to establish harmony between the teeth, jaw, and joint movements to help patients achieve the confident smile they deserve.

Dr. Iranmanesh’s fascination with healthy mouths and beautiful smiles started early in life. As a boy, he was unhappy with the look of his own teeth, which sparked his initial interest. An uncle with a cleft palate further heightened his awareness of how the mouth affects someone’s overall health. While studying the specialty of prosthodontics at Boston University, he fulfilled his desire to tackle challenging dental cases to create long-lasting solutions.

For Dr. Iranmanesh, the satisfaction of solving complex cases is second only to the joy he receives from relationships forged with patients. “When my patients see their new smile for the first time, I am delighted to see the impact that I have made in their life. However, the impact patients make on my life is more than words can describe.”

He describes one moment in particular that reminded him of the power a smile can bring. “A 78-year-old patient, the grandmother of a family who are also my patients, came in to have a veneer procedure done,” Dr. Iranmanesh explains. “Her family was hesitant, but they trusted me and supported her decision. The day we delivered the veneers, it improved her smile so much that she cried, which made me cry as well. Having a naturally beautiful smile was a dream that she had carried for so long, and I was so happy to help her reach her goal.”

Patients visiting Dr. Iranmanesh are greeted by his own family with whom he shares the practice: his wife, Dr. Freshte Esfahanian, a general dentist; his son, Dr. Nima Iranmanesh, a prosthodontist; and his daughter-in-law, Dr. Armita Mashkouri, a periodontist. “As a family, we make sure that every patient receives the red-carpet treatment from the moment they walk in,” he says. “Our mission is to ensure our patients receive the smile that they deserve.”
