Montefiore St. Luke's Cornwall delivers a breadth of leading-edge medical care without the city commute.

NEWLY EXPANDED SERVICES

The hospital's Newburgh campus provides comprehensive inpatient, acute care, and surgical services, as well as a Level III Trauma Center and a neonatal intensive care unit. Its surgical subspecialties include, but are not limited to, total joint replacement, metabolic and bariatric, thoracic, and extensive cardiovascular and urological services.



With a dedication to continually aligning services with patient needs, MSLC has a laser focus on outpatient services at the Cornwall campus. This includes the Littman Cancer Center, offering advanced radiation oncology. There is also an expanded Rehabilitative Medicine Center, including Cardiac and Pulmonary Rehabilitation, Cognitive Medicine, and a Memory Clinic, as well as a wound care and hyperbaric medicine division, among numerous other services.

Most recently, a grant from the New York State Department of Health made possible the new Open Access Primary Care Center, an outpatient facility with walk-in availability and expanded hours. Coming soon will be an advanced imaging suite, a retail pharmacy, and a chronic disease clinic.

"All these services are located under one roof at the Cornwall campus," notes Cusack-McGuirk. "Healthcare needs are ever-evolving, and we're committed to the ongoing delivery of accessible, exceptional outpatient services."

The COVID-19 Resource Center

Launched in December 2020, MSLC's COVID-19 vaccination program was spearheaded by President and COO Daniel Maughan, MSN, MBA, FNP-C, and facilitated by a multi-disciplinary team affectionately called the "COVID Busters." This team has safely and effectively vaccinated thousands of residents throughout New York. Going forward, the MSLC team will continue to advocate for the vaccination of community members to help protect frontline workers and reduce the devastation of the virus.

"The COVID-19 pandemic continues to sweep throughout our nation, but with the unwavering support of our community, MSLC is able to continue providing the high-quality and compassionate care that each patient deserves," says Cusack-McGuirk.
