Positioned on Vanderbilt Drive’s northern fringes, close to Wiggins Pass, and on the northwest edge of North Naples, this tropical haven provides an active and healthy lifestyle to more than 200 residences, including more than 300 independent residents and more than 25 assisted living residents who partake in on-site, community-organized events and excursions. The Colonnade Room gives great views of



the pool, garden, and lake while residents enjoy the chef-created menus. They can also explore the nearby cultural and recreational attractions of Naples and Bonita Springs in their free time.

However, care and community take precedence. “We pride ourselves on being overstaffed,” Whitten says. Licensed, full-time nurses and nursing assistants provide quick care for Arbor Glen’s assisted living residents. Every resident has peace of mind that care is available with the community-wide pendant system, should an unexpected health emergency occur. There’s also a robust dining staff, two activity directors, an on-site real estate department, housekeeping, maintenance, and transportation options for appointments and outings.

At the heart of this community lies functional lifestyle programming that spans over a vast 36,000-square-foot clubhouse, complemented by an outdoor heated pool and spa. Health and wellness services, including Tai Chi, yoga, and lifelong learning programs, are all available.
