Sundial Bridge: This unique structure is both a work of art and a feat of engineering celebrating its 20th anniversary in July 2024. This iconic structure spans the Sacramento River without water supports, featuring a glass deck and a soaring 217-foot pylon that doubles as a functional sundial. Open 24/7 with free access, it offers breathtaking views, connects to an extensive trail network, and reigns as Redding's most photographed landmark.
